## Candle Lighting for Hanukkah

Regular Prayer Book p.363

The Ḥanukkah lights are kindled after Kaddish Titkabbal at the close of the `Amidah of the Evening Service; but on the eve of the Shabbath they are lighted in the home before the Shabbat lights, and in the Synagogue before the evening service. On the going out of the Shabbat they are lighted in Synagogue before the Habdalah, but in the home after the Habdalah.

After the first night, each succeeding light is set to the left of those of the preceeding evenings. The following blessings are chanted before the lights are kindled, standing.

On the first night, add Sheheḥeyanu: Barukh attah Adonai, Elohenu melekh ha`olam, sheheḥeyanu, vekiyyemanu, vehiggi`anu **lazzeman hazzeh**.

On kindling the lights from left to right chant the following:
Hannerot hallalu anu madlikim, `al hannissim, ve`al happurkan, ve`al haggeburot, ve`al hatteshu`ot, ve`al hannifla'ot, ve`al hanneḥamot, she`asita la'abotenu bayyamim hahem ubazzeman hazzeh, `al yede kohanekha hakkedoshim. Vekhol shemonat yemei ḥanukkah hannerot hallalu kodesh hem, ve'en lanu reshut lehishtammesh bahem, ella lir'otam bilbad, kedei lehodot lishmekha, `al nissekha, ve`al yeshu`otekha, ve`al nifle'otekha.
