Rosh Hodesh Ab begins on Thursday night.

The Three Weeks between the Fast of the 17th of Tammuz and the Fast of the 9th of Ab are a traditional period of contrition and mourning, and prophetic passages of reproof and ominous foreboding are designated as the *haftarah* readings on the three intervening Sabbaths.

Sephardic custom is to refer to these Sabbaths by the opening words of the particular *haftarah* read on that day. The three are: Shabbat Dibre, Shabbat Shim'u, & Shabbat Hazon. All three are chanted in a dirge of lament, although each ends on a note of comfort. **Shabbat Dibre** is the first; its *haftarah* is the opening of Jeremiah.
