**The Three Weeks** between the Fast of the 17th of Tammuz and the Fast of the 9th of Ab are a traditional period of contrition and mourning, and prophetic passages of reproof and ominous foreboding are designated as the *haftarah* readings on the three intervening Sabbaths. Sephardic custom is to refer to these Sabbaths by the opening words of the particular *haftarah* read on that day. **Shabbat Shimu** continues the theme of reproof and ominous foreboding with a reading from the second chapter of Jeremiah.
