Shearith Israel's distinguished Polonies Talmud Torah School (PTTS) is again offering highly subsidized one-on-one tutoring customized to your child's needs. Registration is open now and sessions begin in late October. Whether your priority is Hebrew language skills, Jewish culture, familiarity with prayer services, Western Sephardic tradition, and, of course, positive engagement with Jewish life and community, you choose which tutor you'd like to work with based on your own considerations.

Who is eligible: Shearith Israel members and non-members, although the subsidy is greater for members. Additional financial assistance may be available for families in need.

Who are the tutors: Experienced teaching Judaic studies to young learners, they vary in specific areas of expertise and teaching styles. These are independent tutors who are known to us but not employed by Congregation Shearith Israel.
