## A NOTE FROM OUR SHAMASH

This past Thursday marked the *nahala* of Joseph M. Corcos (1872-1926), who served as hazzan of our congregation from 1919 to 1922. He came from a distinguished rabbinical lineage, his grandfather, Abraham Corcos, had served as a *Dayan* of the Spanish and Portuguese Jews of England. Hazan Corcos received his rabbinical education in Mogador, Morocco, under Judah BenAttar, and received *semikha* from Moses Gaster in London. From 1893-1903 he served as minister in the Spanish & Portuguese congregations of Jamaica and of Curacao. During this time, he authored a catechism for the Hebrew School of Jamaica and became the first person to publish a History of the Jews of Curacao. He later moved to New York, where he pursued a business career.

When Dr. Pool left for the Holy Land in 1919, Joseph Corcos was appointed "Acting Minister" of Shearith Israel, serving until Dr. Pool's return in 1922. In 1922, he was appointed hazzan in Montreal, where he remained until 1925. Sadly, he passed away in January 1926 at the age of fifty-three. The version of "Bendigamos" that we sing today was composed and transmitted to our congregation from Curacao by hazzan Corcos.

One of Joseph & Angelita's children, Vida Corcos, met her husband, Fred Simons, at Shearith Israel's "Young People's Group." Fred, a recent immigrant from Holland escaping the growing Nazi threat, and Vida were married in our synagogue on January 18, 1944, eighty years ago this week. After their marriage, Fred was sent back to Europe as a GI. Upon his return from the War, he convinced Vida that the only place for Jews to live was Palestine. They made the move to Israel in 1951 with two children, David and Anita. They remained in Israel for the rest of their lives, raised four children, enjoyed fifteen grandchildren, and were blessed with twenty-two great-grandchildren. Despite the distance, they always remained close friends of our congregation.

This Shabbat, Anita Tamari, Fred and Vida's daughter, is visiting from Kfar Saba, Israel. She generously sponsored the *kiddush* this Shabbat in honor of her parents' wedding anniversary. Over the years, Anita has visited Shearith Israel from Israel with many of her grandchildren. We pray that the memory of her parents and grand- parents continues to thrive in her family and in our congregation for years to come.
