The Three Weeks

Tues, July 23 (Fast of the 17th of Tammuz) to Tues, August 13 (Tisha B'Ab)

The 3 weeks between the 17 of Tammuz and the 9 of Ab are a traditional period of contrition and mourning, and prophetic passages of reproof and ominous foreboding are designated as the *haftarah* readings on the three intervening Sabbaths. Sephardic custom is to refer to these Sabbaths by the opening words of the particular *haftarah* read on that day.

The three are: Shabbat Dibre, Shabbat Shim'u, and Shabbat Hazon. All are chanted in a dirge of lament, although each ends on a note of comfort.
